Currently there are no exams scheduled on the 26th June. In the event of a regional or national incident, the awarding bodies may decide to cancel exams on one or more days and re-schedule them to the end of the summer exams; the 26th June 2019 has been allocated for this purpose. The awarding bodies advise that any student sitting external exams next summer remain available to attend the Academy until the 26th June, regardless of their final exam date on their summer exam timetable. Therefore, holidays etc. should be booked after this date. If there are no incidents, when an individual student's last written exam has taken place, as per their exam timetable, the contingency day for that student becomes obsolete.
