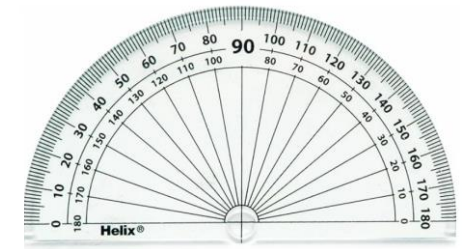


PREPARATION FOR MOCK EXAMS IN GCSE MATHS

Tuesday 28th November – Paper 2 – Calc – Afternoon




Thursday 30th November – Paper 3 – Calc – Afternoon

Build Knowledge


- Create a list of areas you need to work on from the Progress Tests and work on building knowledge through Sparx Maths



- Type into search bar any topics that you need to focus on and work through these questions. There are videos attached to each question for support

Practice through Past Papers

- Access past papers on Maths Genie (search in Google) and use Edexcel resources.
